Crisp, delicate lemony character and an aromatic, dry, refreshing finish.
3. Rivarose Prestige, Royal Provence NV
Provence, France (12% abv)
Mouth filling and fine. Flavours of red berries and a little spice.



CHAMPAGNE

4. Grande Réserve Premier Cru, Gobillard NV
Champagne, France (12.5% abv)
Delicate with a long finish dominated by toasty brioche notes.
5. Baron De Marck Brut, Gobillard NV
Champagne, France (12.5% abv)
Clean and soft. Bursting with apples and pears.
6. Cordon Rouge Brut, Mumm NV
Champagne, France (12% abv)
Peach and apricot flavours with subtle hints of toasted nuts and vanilla.
